- 4. Deep Dive, Human Rights Campaign Municipal Equality Index
 - From the Human Rights Campaign: The Municipal Equality Index (MEI) examines how inclusive municipal laws, policies, and services are of LGBTQ people who live and work there. Cities are rated based on non-discrimination laws, the municipality as an employer, municipal services, law enforcement and the city leadership's public position on equality.
 - In 2017, the City of Atlanta received a perfect score on the MEI.
